

## HOMONYMS

Homonyms wo shabd hote hain jinka ek jaisa uchcharan ya spelling ek jaisi hoti hai lekin arth dono ke alag hote hai. Ye do tarah ke hote hain. Homophones & Homographs

**Homophones:** Jin shabdo ka sound ek jaisa hota hai par spelling aur meaning dono alag hoti hai, use homophones kahte hai.

HOMO ("same") + PHONE ("sound")

Examples: their & there; deer & dear; hear & here; to, too & two, etc.

**Homographs:** Jin shabdo ki spelling ek jaisi hoti par meaning alag hoti hai aur kuch shabdo ke sound bhi alag hote hai.

HOMO ("same") + GRAPH ("writing")

Examples: Tear (*aansun*) - Tears in her eyes & Tear (*phadna*) - Tear from here,

Well (*theek*) - I'm well & Well (*Kuwan*) - I have a deep well,

1. BALL (to play ball) / BALL (to open a ball)
2. BAND (a rock band) / BAND (a rubber band)
3. BANK (the bank of the river) – BANK (put the money in the bank)
4. BEAR (with bare hands) / BEAR (I can't bear it; the polar bear)
5. BARK (the dog barked at me) / BARK (the bark of a tree)
6. BAT (blind as a bat) / BAT (a baseball bat)
7. CLIP (to clip the hedge) / CLIP (a paper clip)
8. CRICKET (a cricket game) / CRICKET (a type of insect)
9. FAIR (that's fair) / FAIR (book fair / bus fare)
10. FINE (one fine day) / FINE (to pay a fine for speeding)
11. GROUND (to fall to the ground) / GROUND (freshly ground coffee)
12. KITE (festival of kite) / KITE (an eagle)
13. LIGHT (bright light) – LIGHT (as light as a feather / light rain)
14. WELL (very well) – WELL (a deep well)
15. TIP (the tip of the tongue) / TIP (to give a tip)
