

SILENT LETTER WORDS

Silent letters wo hote jo sound nahin kiye jate par shabd ki meaning badal dete hai.
Inko prayog kar naye shabd banae gaye. Halaki, inmein kai apvad bhi hote hai.

Silent 'b' after (baad) 'm' and before (pahle) 't'.

Examples: com(b), tom(b), clim(b), dou(b)t, de(b)t, su(b)tle, etc.

Silent 'c' before 'z', 'k', 'l' & after 's'.

Examples: (C)zarina, blo(c)k, ba(c)k, mus(c)le, s(c)issors, etc.

Silent 'd' before 'n' & 'g'.

Examples: We(d)nesday, ca(d)ge, e(d)ge, etc.

Silent 'e' if it is at end of a word or before 'd' in past participle case.

Examples: bit(e), kit(e), call(e)d, play(e)d, etc.

Silent 'g' before 'n' & 'h'.

Examples: assi(g)n, desi(g)n, rei(g)n, ti(g)ht, (g)host, etc.™

Silent 'h' before 'o' after 'r' & 'ex'.

Examples: (h)onest, (h)our, r(h)yme, ex(h)aust, ex(h)hibition, etc.

Silent 'k' before 'n'

Examples: k(n)ee, k(n)ow, k(n)ock, etc.

Silent 'l' before 'k'.

Examples: fo(l)k, ta(l)k, wa(l)k, etc.

Silent 'n' after 'm'.

Examples: colum(n), autum(n), hym(n), etc.

Silent 'p' before 's'.

Examples: (P)sychology, (p)salm, (p)sychiatry, etc.

Silent 't' after 's' & before 'ch', if it is in middle of a word.

Examples: Chris(t)mas, fas(t)en, wa(t)ch, etc.

Silent 'u' before 'g'.

Examples: g(u)ard, g(u)est, g(u)ess, etc.

Silent 'w' before 'r'.

Examples: (w)rite, (w)rong, (w)rist, etc.
