:: WANT, NEED & LIKE ::

Is lesson mein aap chahat, zarurat aur pasand ko vyakt karna sikhenge. Singular subject ke sath verb mein 's' ya 'es' lagate hai, jabki plural subject ke sath verb mein 's' ya 'es' nahi lagate hai.

Singular subject: He, She, It, Name or single thing.

Plural subject: I, We, You, They or plural things.

'Want' Sentences: Jab chahat vyakt karna ho.

Sentence Frame: Subject + want + s/es + Object



1. He wants your bicycle.
(Wah tumhari bicycle chahta hai.)



2. She wants my pen drive.
(Wah meri pen drive chahti hai.)



3. Sam wants fried chicken.
(Sam tala hua chicken chahta hai.)



4. My boss wants that deal.
(Mera boss wo deal chahte hain.)



5. You want your grands back.
(Tum apne dada-dadi ko wapas chahte ho.)



6. I want a swipe machine.
(Mujhe swipe machine chahiye.)



7. They want your presentation.
(Ve tumhara presentation chahte hain.)



8. His son wants a flight journey.
(Uska beta jahaz ka safar chahta hai.)



9. People want security.
(Log suraksha chahte hain.)



10. We want free time.
(Hume khali samay chahiye.)

'Need' Sentences: Jab zarurat vyakt karna ho.

Sentence Frame: Subject + need + s/es + Object



1. Usha needs time.
(Usha ko samay ki zrurat hai.)



2. He needs delivery today.
(Use pahuchane ki aaj zarurat hai.)



3. It needs less fuel.
(Ise kam edhan ki zarurat hai.)



4. Harry needs a digital camera.
(Harry ko digital camera ki zarurat hai.)



5. Daddy needs medicine.
(Daddy ko dava ki zarurat hai.)



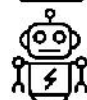
6. You need software.
(Tumhe software ki zarurat hai.)



7. We need good income.
(Hume achchi income ki zarurat hai.)



8. They need treatment.
(Unhe ilaj ki zarurat hai.)



9. Women need safety.
(Aurton ko suraksha ki zarurat hai.)



10. People need freedom.
(Logon ko azaadi ki zarurat hai.)

'Like' Sentences: Jab pasand vyakt karna ho.

Sentence Frame: Subject + like+ s/es + Object



1. He likes his village.
(Use uska gaon pasand hai.)



2. She likes 7 stars hotel only.
(Use 7 sitara hotel hi pasand hai.)



3. Kareem likes news.
(Kareem ko samachar pasand hai.)



4. Government likes GST.
(Sarkar GST pasand karti hai.)



5. My mother likes peace.
(Meri maa shanti pasand karti hai.)



6. You like my dance.
(Tum mera nach pasand karti ho.)



7. I like vanilla ice-cream. (Main Vanilla ice-cream pasand karti hoon.)



8. They like this place.
(Ve is jagah ko pasand karte hain.)



9. We like his music. (Hum uske sangeet ko pasand karte hain.)



10. Children like its taste. (Bachche iska swad pasand karte hai.)

Past Sentences: Jab chahat, zarurat aur pasand ko bhutkal mein vyakt karna ho.

Sentence Frame: Subject + want / need / like + ed + Object

- He wanted a good offer.
- We needed purified water.
- Thomas liked his behaviour.
- She liked pamphlet distribution.
- I wanted to buy shoe.

(Wah ek achcha offer chahta tha.)
(Use chhane hue pani ki zarurat thi.)
(Thomos ko uska vyavhar pasand tha.)
(Use pamphlet batna pasand tha.)
(Main juta khareedna chahta tha.)

Negative Sentences: Jab chahat, zarurat aur pasand ko me nakaratmak vyakt karna ho.

Sentence Frame: Subject + don't / doesn't / didn't + want / need / like + ed + Object

- You don't want milk of cow.
- She doesn't need water.
- I didn't like that shirt.
- He doesn't want any email.
- David doesn't like traveling.

(Tum gaay ka doodh nahin chahte ho.)
(Use paani ki zarurat nahin hai.)
(Mujhe woh shirt nahin pasand thi.)
(Wah koi email nahin chahta hai.)
(David ko travelling nahin pasand hai.)

Interrogative Sentences: Jab kisi ki chahat, zarurat aur pasand puchhana ho.

Sentence Frame: Do/Does/Did + Subject + want/need/like + Object

- Do you want money?
- Does she want to meet?
- Do I need extra income?
- Does he like this season?
- Did they like cash?

(Kya tum paise chahte ho?)
(Kya wah milna chahti hai?)
(kya mujhe aur aay ki zarurat hain?)
(Kya use yah mausam pasand hai?)
(Kya unhe cash pasand tha?)
