Is lesson mein aap bhavishya mein lene wale action ko batana sikhenge.

Planning for a picnic: *Jab koi picnic ki tayyari karni ho.*

Sentence Frame: Subject + will/shall + Verb 1st + Object



1. I shall book a hotel near the station. (Main station ke paas ek hotel book karunga.)



3. The hotel will manage a cab in the morning. (Hotel subah mein cab manage karega.)



2. We shall go to the spot by cab. (Hum sthan car se jayenge.)



4. They will give their service till 8 p.m. (Ve waha apni seva 8 baje tak denge.)

Preparation for Diwali: *Jab kisi festival ki tayyari batani ho.*

Sentence Frame: Subject + will/shall + Verb 1st + Object



1. My father will take 7 days leaves. (Mere pita 7 din ki chutti lenge.)



3. I shall buy a new dress today. (Main aaj naye kapde khareedunga.)



2. My mother will prepare some sweets. (Meri maa kuch mithai banayegi.)



4. My brother will put a light in the balcony. (Mera bhai balcony me light rakhega.)

Expectation on the day of festival: *Jab kisi festival ke din kisi action ki ummid karna ho.*

Sentence Frame: Subject + will/shall + be + Verb 1st + ing + Object



1. My friends will be reaching in a few minutes. (Mere dost kuch hi der mein pahunch rahe honge.)



3. John will be driving the car. (John car chala rahe honge.)



2. They will be buying gifts. (Ve gift khareed rahe honge.)



4. Tom will be bargaining. (Tom mol bhav kar raha hoga.)

Expectation after the festival: *Jab kisi festival ke baad kisi action ko ho jane ki ummid karna ho.*

Sentence Frame: Subject + will/shall + be + Verb 1st + ing + Object



1. We shall have dropped them by 10 p.m. (Hum unhe 10 baje tak chhod chuke honge.)



3. My brother will have parked the car after that. (Mere bhai uske baad car khadi kar chuke honge.)



2. I shall have closed the door. (Main darwaza band kar chuka hoonga.)



4. You will have slept by 1 a.m. (Tum 1 baje tak so chuke hoge.)

General Future Sentences: *Jab bhavishya ke liye kisi action ki baat ki jaye.*

Sentence Frame: Subject + will/shall + be + Verb 1st + ing + Object



1. We shall visit there to see you. (Hum wahan tumhe dekhne ayenge.)



3. I shall be watching cricket to pass my time. (Main apna samay pass karne ke liye cricket dekhunga.)



2. Kaif will have met you to tell about me. (Kaif tumse mil chuka hoga mere bare mein batane ke liye.)



4. He will be listening to music to enjoy the moment. (Wah pal enjoy karne ke liye music sun rahe honge.)

Negative Sentences: *Jab bhavishya me liye ja rahe / chuke action ko nakaratmak batana ho.*
Sentence Frame: Subject + will/shall + not + Verb 1st + Object

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| • I shall not buy the phone. | (Mai phone nahin khareedunga.) |
| • We won't go for it. | (Hum uske liye nahin jayenge.) |
| • They will not be reaching there. | (Vo wahan nahin pahuch rahe honge.) |
| • Hina won't have deposited money. | (Hina rupay nahin jama ki hogi.) |
| • You shall not have been coming since 2 o'clock. | (Tum 2 baje se nahin aa rahe hoge.) |

Interrogative Sentences: *Jab bhavishya mein liye ja rahe action pe prashna puchhna ho.*
Sentence Frame: Subject + will/shall + not + Verb 1st + Object

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| • Shall I play the music? | (Kya main sangeet bajaunga?) |
| • Will you pass this message? | (Kya aap yah message pass karoge?) |
| • Shall we plan the journey? | (Kya hum safar karne ka plan karenge?) |
| • Will he pay those bills? | (Kya wah wo bill ada karega?) |
| • Will she pack my luggage? | (kya wah mera saman pack karegi?) |
