Sold : Her mother sold the property.
Sold : Her mother has sold the property.
4. Pull (*Khichna*) : Our brother pulls the door.
Pulled : Our brother pulled the door.
Pulled : Our brother had pulled the door.
5. Beg (*Nivedan Karna*) : Your partner begs for her chance.
Begged : Your partner begged for her chance.
Begged : Your partner had begged for her chance.
