Is lesson mein aap 'Article' ke bare mein samjhenge. 'A', 'An' & 'The' article hote hain. 'A' or 'An' kisi unknown noun (agyaat sangya) ke sath aata hai aur 'The' kisi known noun ke sath aata hai.

Example: I have a car. (Mere paas ek gaadi hai.)

Isme jis car ki baat ki ja rahi hai, use aapne nahi dekha hai ya uske bare mein nahin jante hai.

Example: I have the car. (Mere paas gaadi hai.)

'the car' ka matlab aap us gaadi ko jante hai.

'An' ka use vowel se shuru hone wale noun ke sath karte hai aur 'A' ka use consonant se shuru hone wale noun ke sath karte hain.

Examples: An apple, An egg, An ice-cream, An orange, An umbrella, etc.

A, E, I, O aur U ko vowel kaha jata hai. In letters ko ya inse shuru hue shabd ko bolne mein mukh ka koi bhi hissa ek dusre ko nahin chhuta hai.

Examples: A cat, A dog, A fish, A girl, A hen, etc.

Vowel ke alawa bache hue 21 letters ko consonants kahte hai. Inko sound karne mein mukh ka koi bhi hissa ek doosre ko touch kar sakta hai.
