*Is lesson mein aap chahat, zarurat aur pasand ko vyakt karna sikhenge. Singular subject ke sath verb mein 's' ya 'es' lagate hai, jabki plural subject ke sath verb mein 's' ya 'es' nahi lagate hai.*

Singular subject: He, She, It, Name or single thing.

Plural subject: I, We, You, They or plural things.

Sentence Frame: Subject + don't / doesn't / didn't + want / need / like + Object

**Interrogative Sentences:** *Jab kisi ki chahat, zarurat aur pasand puchhana ho.*

Sentence Frame: Do / Does / Did + Subject + want / need / like + Object
