

**DAY 17**  
**:: VERB + TO ::**

**Has / Have / Had / Want / Need / Like + 'To'**

*Is lesson mein aap sikhenge ki subject ko kaun sa action lena hai ya tha. Is sentence ke verb mein 'To + Verb 1st' ka upyog karna sikhenge. 'To' ke sath verb ki 1<sup>st</sup> form hi lagani hoti hai.*

**'Has' with Verb:** Jab singular subject ko koi action karna hi ho.

Sentence Frame: Subject + has + to + Verb 1st + Object



1. Ram has to find a solution.  
(Ram ko Iska samadhan dhundna hai.)



3. Boss has to convince him.  
(Boss ko use samjhana hai.)



2. He has to call all clients.  
(Use sare clients ko call karna hai.)



4. She has to report to her boss.  
(Use apne boss ko report karna hai.)

- Adil has to pass it.
- His staff has to deliver.
- A girl has to meet you.
- She has to finish this.
- A boy has to try that.
- The man has to sleep.

**'Have' with Verb:** Jab plural subject ko koi action karna hi ho.

Sentence Frame: Subject + have + to + Verb 1st + Object



1. I have to pack my cabin.  
(Mujhe apna cabin pack karna hai.)



3. We have to note the complaints.  
(Hume shikayate likhni hai.)



2. You have to coach your staff.  
(Tumhe apne staff ko sikhana hai.)



4. They have to marry.  
(Unhe shaadi karni hai.)

- They've to take rest.
- My friends have to play.
- We've to pray here.
- I've to propose her.
- Girls have to learn English.
- People have to see him.

**'Had' with Verb:** Jab koi action bhutkal mein karna hi tha.

Sentence Frame: Subject + had + to + Verb 1st + Object



1. I had to check the currency.  
(Mujhe mudra janchna tha.)



3. We had to show the menu.  
(Hume menu dikhana tha.)



2. He had to smoke.  
(Use dhumrapan karna tha.)



4. You had to deposit money.  
(Tumhe rupay jama karna tha.)

- His son had to pick it.
- My dog had to bark.
- They had to deal the flat.
- Kapil had to take a nap.
- Suman had to brush.
- The thief had to escape.

**'Want & Need' with Verb:** Jab subject ko koi action karne ki चाहत या जरूरत हो.

Sentence Frame: Subject + want / need (s) + to + Verb 1st + Object



1. You want to mix this item.  
(Tum is item ko milana chahte ho.)



2. I want to decorate the cake.  
(Main cake sajana chahta hoon.)



3. He needs to bring the cake.  
(Use cake lane ki zarurat hai.)



4. They need to roll the chapati.  
(Unhe chapatti belne ki zarurat hai.)

- She wants to learn it.
- We need to operate now.
- I want to hug his son.
- Ali wants to give me.
- He needs to do pull-ups.
- You need to fight.

**'Like' with Verb:** Jab subject ko koi action karne ki pasand ho.

Sentence Frame: Subject + like (s) + to + verb 1st + Object



1. We like to shake juice.  
(Hum juice ko hilana pasand karte hain.)



3. You like to slice vegetable.  
(Tumhe sabzi katna pasand hai.)



2. She likes to cook a delicious dish.  
(Use mazedar khana banana pasand hai.)



4. They like to order pizza.  
(Unhen pizza order karna pasand hai.)

- I like to travel with you.
- Tony likes to report her.
- We like to fly in the sky.
- He likes to tell me.
- Cats like to have milk.
- Ram likes to love him.

**Past Sentences:** Jab subject ko koi action bhutkal mein karne ki चाहत, जरूरत या pasand ho.

Sentence Frame: Subject + wanted / needed / liked + to + Verb + Object

- He wanted to go for delivery. (Wah delivery ke liye jana chahta tha.)
- I wanted to make French fries. (Main French fries banana chahti thi.)
- You needed to check the taste. (Tumhe swad chakhne ki zarurat thi.)
- They liked to meet the chef. (Unhe bawarchi se milna pasand tha.)
- We had to go in a restaurant. (Hume restaurant mein jana tha.)

**Negative Sentences:** Jab subject ko koi action nakaratmak mein karne ki चाहत, जरूरत या pasand ho.

Sentence Frame: Subject + don't / doesn't / didn't + want / need / like + to + Verb + Object

- She doesn't have to disbalance after wine. (Use sharab pine ke baad ladkhadana nahin hai.)
- We don't have to dine out. (Hume bahar nahin khana hain.)
- I don't want to order a burger. (Main burger nahin order karna chahta hoon.)
- David doesn't need to taste the ice-cream. (David ko ice-cream chakhne ki zarurat nahin hai.)
- You don't like to drink the cold drink. (Tumhe cold drink pina pasand nahin hai.)

**Interrogative Sentences:** Jab subject ko koi action karne ki चाहत, जरूरत या pasand ke liye prashn puchhana ho.

Sentence Frame: Do / Does / Did + Subject + want / need / like + to + Verb + Object

- Do we have to plough a field? (Kya hume khet ki khudai karni hain?)
- Does he have to throw these bags? (Kya use ye bore phakne hai?)
- Did Veena have to bring a pumpkin? (Kya Veena kaddu lana chahti hai?)
- Do you want to sheer ships? (Kya tum bhedo ke baal ki katai karna chahte ho?)
- Does she like to drink fresh milk? (Kya wah taza doodh peena chahti hai?)
