:: PRESENT ROUTINE & SENTENCE ::

Is lesson mein aap vartman mein din bhar ka routine ya kisi action ko batana sikhenge.

Your Routine: *Jab aapko apna din charya (routine) batana ho.*

Sentence Frame: Subject + Verb 1st + Object



1. I wake up early at 6 a.m.
(Main subah 6 baje uthta hoon.)



3. I do exercise at 7 o'clock.
(Main 7 baje vyayam karta hoon.)



2. I brush my teeth.
(Main apne dant brush karta hoon.)



4. I take bath after my gym.
(Main gym karne ke baad nahata hoon.)

- I go to temple everyday.
- I watch T.V. for 2 hours.
- I have my dinner at 8 p.m.
- I do shopping on Friday.
- I play with my friends.
- I sleep around 11 o'clock.

Friends' Routine: *Jab aapko apne dosto ka din charya batana ho.*

Sentence Frame: Subject + Verb 1st + Object



1. My friends come by their car.
(Mera dost apni gaadi se aate hain.)



3. They pass their time in a canteen.
(Ve apna samay canteen mein bitate hain.)



2. They reach college at 10 o'clock.
(Ve 10 baje collage pahuchte hain.)



4. They attend some lectures only.
(Ve kuch hi lectures lete hain.)

- They speak English.
- They meet in the evening.
- They call me at 8 a.m.
- They go by bike.
- They play on weekends.
- They study at night.

Mother's Routine: *Jab aapko apni maa ka din charya batana ho.*

Sentence Frame: Subject + Verb + s/es + Object



1. My mother gets up at 5 a.m.
(Meri maa 5 baje uthti hai.)



3. She goes to church daily.
(Wah roz church jati hai.)



2. She does meditation.
(Wah meditation karti hai.)



4. She gives me a glass of juice.
(Wah mujhe ek glass juice deti hai.)

- She cleans the kitchen.
- She cooks meals for us.
- She prays at 6 o'clock.
- She serves us lunch.
- She wears Indian dresses.
- She likes pizza.

Doctor's Routine: *Jab aapko kisi doctor ka parikshad ya ilaj ka tarika batana ho.*

Sentence Frame: Subject + Verb + s/es + Object



1. My doctor checks blood pressure first.
(Mera doctor pahle blood pressure check karta hai.)



3. He injects an injection.
(Wah injection lagata hai.)



2. He examines the test.
(Wah janch karta hai.)



4. He gives the medicine.
(Wah dava dete hai.)

- The doctor operates well.
- He checks the report.
- He earns from a hospital.
- He cares for his patients.
- He sits in a clinic.
- He works for 10 hours.

General Routine: *Jab aapko kisi ka action ya information batana ho.*

Sentence Frame: Subject + Verb 1st (+ s/es) + to + Verb 1st + Object



1. Franky travels to see the world.
(Franky safar karta hai dunia dekhne ke liye.)



3. I meet him to do business only.
(Mein use sirf business ke liye mila hoon.)



2. You write the SMS to inform him.
(Tum use batane ke liya sms likhte ho.)



4. She visits a dentist to consult.
(Wah daant ke doctor ke paas salah ke liye jati hai.)

- We train English well.
- He dreams to travel.
- They brings a gift for me.
- I get the money for you.
- She carries a luggage.
- Dogs bark at night.

Negative Sentences: *Jab aapko kisi ka action ya information nakaratmak batana ho.*

Sentence Frame: Subject + do / does + not + Verb 1st + Object

- We don't have time. (Humare paas samay nahin hai.)
- She doesn't come on time. (Wah samay par nahin aati hai.)
- I don't hesitate in speaking. (Mujhe bolne mein hichkichahat nahin hoti hai.)
- He doesn't try to get success. (Wah safalta pane ki koshish nahin karta hai.)
- They don't keep any secret. (Ve koi rahasya nahin rakhte hain.)

Interrogative Sentences: *Jab aapko kisi ka action ya information pe prashn puchhna ho.*

Sentence Frame: Do/Does + Subject + not + Verb 1st + Object

- Do I call you at night? (kya main raat mein tumhe call karta hoon?)
- Does Sandy scare? (Kya Sandy darta hai?)
- Does she cook well? (kya wah khana accha banati hai?)
- Do you yawn like this? (kya tum is tarah jamhai lete ho?)
- Do dogs bite? (kya kutte kaatte hai?)
