VERBS

1. Use (*Prayog karna*) : They use my phone.

3. **Burn Down.** (*Jal kar barbaad hona*) : His phone burnt down after the blast.
4. **Burn Up.** (*Krodidh karna*) : Don't burn me up for your nonsense work.
5. **Butt In.** (*Hastkshep karna*) : Please don't butt in our matter.
