1. Tear (*Phadna*) : Teachers tear my letter.  
Tore : Teachers tore my letter.  
Torn : Teachers have torn my letter.
2. Keep (*Rakhna*) : Teachers keep her record.  
Kept : Teachers kept her record.  
Kept : Teachers have kept her record.
3. Begin (*Shuru karna*) : Teachers begin their task.  
Began : Teachers began their task.  
Begun : Teachers have begun their task.
4. Talk (*Baat karna*) : Teachers talk to me.  
Talked : Teachers talked to me.  
Talked : Teachers had talked to me.
5. Turn (*Mudna*) : Teachers turn right.  
Turned : Teachers turned right.  
Turned : Teachers had turned right.
